China-ASEAN Symposium on Artificial Intelligence

"China-ASEAN Symposium on Artificial Intelligence" was held in Guiyang, on July 23, 2019, during the 12th China-ASEAN Education Cooperation Week. Tianjin University and Mahidol University jointly hosted the Symposium. The symposium gathers top scholars from the Chinese and ASEAN universities in the field of intelligence, representatives from the government, embassies and industries to discuss the profound changes that have taken place in the modern era.

Mahidol University Establishes Closer Collaboration with School of Pharmaceutical Science and Technology, Tianjin University.

On 31 July 2019, Assoc. Prof. Sittiwat Lertsiri, Dean of Faculty of Science, Mahidol University, warmly welcomed Prof.Jay Siegel, Dean of School of Pharmaceutical Science and Technology, Tianjin University, P.R. China, and Prof. Kim Baldridge Vice Dean. The meeting coincided with the MOU signing ceremony between two institutions with the aim to promote research and academic collaboration in the area of pharmaceutical science and chemistry.

China-ASEAN Scholar Program

The China-ASEAN Scholar Program is a fellowship program initiated by Tianjin University (TJU). It aims to strengthen academic collaboration between TJU and universities in ASEAN countries through providing funded short-term visit opportunity. Scholars from ASEAN countries will be hosted by one of TJU's academic schools. During the visit, they will work with TJU faculties together for 1 to 3 months in the field of mutual interest. To give greater flexibility for scholars, specific research projects or academic activities will be determined by participants and hosting academic school together based on each case.

Tianjin University will **provide funding** to the participants, including:

- Roundtrip, economy class airfare
- Accommodation

- Monthly Stipend: around 15,000 RMB per month (pre tax) Till now, more than 20 scholars have already applied for the program.

Community and Technological (CommTECH) Camp Insight 2020

This program will incorporate Indonesian language course, traditional music, and dance classes. The courses are designed attractively based on Project-based Learning (PbL) method. Materials have been compiled from many credible resources and added with interesting data and facts that will provide broader and deeper understanding on the topics. "Think Loudly" is a term encouraged in the classroom interaction, in which participants are given great opportunities to articulate their understanding and opinions.

This program will be held for 13 days. The fee to join this program is very affordable, i.e. USD 1,600. The fee will cover airport pick-up and drop-off; accomodition and all scheduled meals; local transportation; course material; workshop tools and materials such as fabrics, t-shirt and backpack; and site visits. Please note that round-trip flight and health insurance are not part of the fee participants should arrange their own health insurance prior to the departure if needed.

The university admitted 1091 international student altogether for the fall 2019 entry, including 438 undergraduate students, 209 master's candidates, 75 doctoral candidates and 369 non-degree students.
